



## Horse Trial Notes

The Horse Trials will run according to the US Equestrian Federation (USEF) rules that apply. However, the event is designed to be a learning experience and the organizer reserves the right to modify the rules and/or combine classes to enhance this experience.

**Awards:** Ribbons through sixth place

**Schooling:** Cross Country Schooling is available the day before the Horse Trials (weather permitting). Schooling may be limited due to footing – please call to verify that schooling is available. **ALL RIDERS** must check in with the secretary to **verify** release forms, fees paid and to receive a number **PRIOR** to entering the Cross Country course. ***Any rider schooling on course without a number will be asked to leave the grounds, will be eliminated from the following day's competition and forfeit any fees paid.***

***Protective vests are mandatory.*** ASTM SEI approved helmets are required while mounted anytime/anywhere on grounds

Only flagged obstacles may be jumped and only in the direction of the flags.

**ALL** riders must be accompanied by an adult ground person.

Weather permitting, stadium and dressage ring schooling may be available for a small additional fee, please check with the secretary for information.

**Refunds and Change Fees: NO REFUNDS** for Entry Fees or Stabling Fees after the closing date. Refund less \$10.00 before closing date. Competitor may find another horse/rider to be substituted in the scheduled division/time slot. Substitution fee is \$10.00

Change Fees: After entry received is \$10.00. Division changes after X-C schooling is \$10.00

**Late Entries:** Late entries may be accepted after closing date if space is available. **A \$20.00 late entry fee check must accompany the entry form.**

Please bring your own water and leave your dogs at home!

Food is available on grounds.
